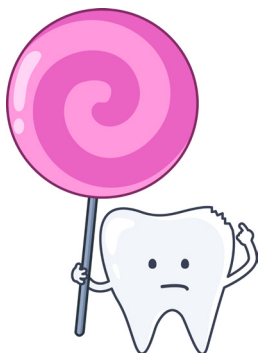


HEY, KIDS! There Are Sneaky Sugars!
