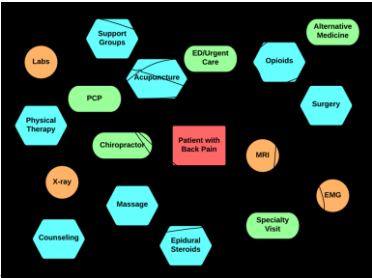

What's happened since we last met?..... Key Initiatives from 2019

- Deepen integration with Primary Care Clinics 
 - Growth of Primary Spine Provider Network
 - Development of regional spine care provider roster
 - Go-live of Spine Line "Provider of the Day"
 - Build out of regional based integrated spine program: Buffalo, Faribault, and Cambridge/Isanti
- Focus on opiate reduction and raising awareness throughout CSI 
 - Reduced MEDD for post-operative surgical cases
 - Aligned with system wide Pain Steering Committee
 - ICSI community workgroup participation
- Launched spine robotics capabilities at Abbott Northwestern 
 - 10+ surgeons completed training
 - 20 cases completed thus far in 2019

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Key initiatives from 2019 (con't)

- Continued focus on spine surgical outcomes 
- Build-out of Interventional Spine Practice 
 - 3 locations in the west region
 - One phone number for scheduling
- Developed partnership with Aetna/Allina Health Plan 
 - Reviewed de-identified data on spine care within Allina
 - Confirmed opportunity for differentiated spine care pilot for 2020 within new Allina Value plan called "Elevate"
- Physical Therapy MedX equipment upgrade and expansion to Buffalo market 
- Added/Expanded Chiropractic services in Buffalo, Coon Rapids, and Woodbury 

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2020 Projected Areas of Focus

- Partnering with payer groups to explore innovative care & financial models, including total cost of care improvements and shared savings
 - Go-live of Aetna/Allina Elevate Plan with a focused spine care pathway
 - Further integrate with Blue Cross Blue Shield and HealthPartners
- Further investment in regional spine programs
 - Faribault, Buffalo, Cambridge, and Isanti
 - Assess opportunity for growth in new markets
- Work with Customer Experience Center and Primary Care to drive early and direct access to Chiro and PT
- Allina Advanced Spine and Interdisciplinary Rotation with NWHSU

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2020 Projected Areas of Focus

- Address length of stay concerns for inpatient, non-operative spine
 - Potential pilot of acute spine clinic to serve Mercy ED
 - Education and support of hospitalists within United and ANW
- Start process for enrolling Abbott Northwestern as a Center of Excellence for Spine Surgery
 - Identifies areas of opportunity to improve consumer experience
 - Identifies areas of unnecessary variation
 - Re-invigorates the quality and value agenda
- In conjunction with Allina ELT, develop an Ambulatory Surgery Strategy
