Top athletes in both the Championship and Consolation Divisions will be honored with All-Tournament Team selections, recognizing excellence at every field position. All awards will be handed out at the Tournament Awards Banquet from 6-8pm in the Mall of America® Overlook room on Floor 6, north entrance. Attendees must <u>purchase a ticket</u>.

Individual awards celebrate standout performances and sportsmanship throughout the tournament. Honors include Best Hitter, Golden Glove, Rookie of the Year, and class-based awards (Class I–IV and Best Quad). The Hank Quien Sportsmanship Award highlights character and integrity, while the prestigious Lawrence Randell MVP Award recognizes the most impactful player in each division.



Transportation

Transportation is on your own. Metro Transit offers great options to get around town by light rail or bus. Uber, Lyft, and other ride-share and taxis are readily available in the Twin Cities area.

From the MSP airport: The <u>METRO Blue Line</u> offers fast, frequent service from the airport's Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 stations to Mall of America and downtown Minneapolis (Target Field). Trains leave roughly every 15 minutes during most hours on weekdays, every 15-30 minutes on evenings and weekends. Travel time from MSP Airport to MOA is 12 minutes. <u>More about riding the train.</u>
