This program is designed to accommodate those who are new to golf or are returning to the game after the onset of a disability.

WEEKLY PROGRAM OFFERING

Lesson-based program

Golfers, beginner to advanced, will work one-on-one with a volunteer who will provide personalized instruction and support as you learn the game. Each week you will practice golf techniques on the putting green, driving range, or the executive course.

Eagle Lake Golf Course, Plymouth MN

Golfers will receive an adaptive golf pass to go golfing outside of the program (specific to this site)

The Loop at Chaska, Chaska MN

Golfers will receive 1-2 golf passes to go golfing outside of the program. (specific to this site)

Non-competitive league-based program:

Golfers will play on a 3 par 9 hole executive course with 1–2 other participants and 1–2 volunteers to support. Each golfer will receive an assigned tee time within the program window, and the site coordinator will contact you beforehand with your scheduled time.

MGA & CKRI Adaptive Golf Clinics

Courage Kenny Sports & Recreation (CKRI) and Minnesota Golf Association (MGA) will be partnering this summer to host a series of adaptive golf clinics within the twin cities area. We will offer both beginner and intermediate clinics for individuals (youth and adults) with cognitive disabilities, physical disabilities, and visual impairments.

COST:

Lesson-based program- includes equipment, green fees, instruction, and golf pass(es)

- Eagle Lake Golf Course (5 weeks): \$125
- The Loop at Chaska (10 weeks): \$165

Non-competitive league-based program

- **Registration fee:** \$50
- **Course green fees-** paid weekly to the course
 - Braemar Golf Course: \$20 (+ tax)
 - Island Lake Golf Course: \$16 (+ tax)
 - Oak Glen Golf Course: \$24 (+ tax)
