Hip Aspiration/Injection

Before the Procedure

- Tell the technologist if you are breastfeeding, pregnant or think you may be pregnant.
- You will wear a hospital gown.
- The procedure takes about 30 minutes.

During the Procedure

- The radiologist will numb your hip with a medicine similar to Novocain[®].
- He or she will insert a needle into your hip joint to collect some fluid.
- The fluid will go to the lab for testing.

After the Procedure

- Your hip may feel sore. You may take pain relievers such as acetaminophen (Tylenol[®]) to relieve your discomfort. Follow the package directions.
- Call your health care provider if you are in a lot of pain.
- Limit your activities for the rest of the day.
