# Home Infusion Emergency Plan

#### **Being Prepared for Emergencies**

Managing your home infusion needs can be more challenging during an emergency such as a:

- major storm
- loss of electricity
- need to leave (evacuate) your home.

Making a plan will help you be prepared to manage your home infusion needs even if an emergency occurs.

## Supplies to Have on Hand

Make sure you have the following items on hand at all times.

- ☐ at least a 1-week supply of all of your medicines
- ☐ supplies to give your medicines:
  - ☐ saline and heparin flushes
  - ☐ alcohol wipes
- ☐ SASH Method teaching mat
- ☐ at least a 3-day supply of bottled water
- ☐ at least a 2-day supply of ready-to-eat foods such as:
  - canned tuna or tuna in a pouch
  - canned beans
  - crackers
  - nuts or nut butters
  - high-fiber or high-protein bars
  - dried fruit

- ☐ first aid supplies such as:
  - bandages
  - cotton swabs
  - antibiotic ointments
- ☐ extra clothing
- ☐ cell phone charger
- □ extra AA batteries (if you are using a pump)
- ☐ infusion pump charger
- ☐ flashlight and extra batteries
- □ cash

If your medicines need to be kept in the refrigerator, you will also need to keep the following items on hand.

- □ cooler
- ☐ reusable cold packs (Do <u>not</u> use dry ice.)

**Important:** Do <u>not</u> freeze your medicines.

## Information to Keep on Hand

Make sure to keep the following information on hand at all times.

- □ a list of each of the following:
  - □ other medical problems (conditions)
  - □ allergies
  - ☐ any surgeries you've had
  - current medicines (prescription, overthe-counter, herbals, vitamins and other supplements) with the dose and time you take them

— name
— address
— phone number
your health care provider's information:
— name
— address
— phone number
phone numbers and email addresses for your family, friends and a work contact
copy of your health insurance card
copy of your photo identification (ID) card
