Before the Exam

- Do not eat or drink for 8 hours before the exam.
- Tell your doctor if you are pregnant.

During the Exam

- You will get an injection of a radioactive material.
- The radioactive material will help your liver, gallbladder and small bowel show up on the scan.
- You will lie on your back on the exam table.
- A camera will take pictures of your abdomen.
- You need to lie still.
- The exam takes about 90 minutes.
