

Care After Local Anesthesia

General Information

You have remained awake during your surgery. The medicine you received was injected directly into the surgery site. The medicine numbed the area so you didn't feel any pain during surgery.

Depending on the medicine used, you may feel comfortable for several hours.

Activity

- You may return to your normal home activities as directed by your health care provider.

Medicine/Discomfort

- If your health care provider ordered pain medicine, take it as prescribed.

Diet

- You may resume your normal diet.
