Available for you to use during your appointment

Changing Rooms

Changing rooms are available to give you a private space to change and get ready for your treatment. There is also a place to securely store your belongings.

Please use the changing rooms each time you arrive for your treatment. You may need to come early so that you can get changed and be ready for your treatment at your appointment time.

If you need any help getting changed, please tell the front desk staff or any member of your radiation therapy team.

When You Arrive

- There are two changing rooms. One room is next to LINAC A and the other room is next to LINAC B. Each room is gender neutral. You can use either room, but if possible, please use the room closest to your treatment machine.
- Gowns, pants and robes are in each changing room for you to use.
- Lockers are in each changing room for you to store your belongings.

Getting Ready for Your Treatment

Upper body (abdominal area, breast, lung, esophagus, upper spine)

For treatment on your upper body, you will:

- undress from the waist up. Please remove your bra and any jewelry.
- put on a gown, with the opening in the back, and a robe.

Lower body (pelvic area, legs, lower spine)

For treatment on your lower body, you will:

- undress from the waist down. You may keep your underwear, socks and shoes on.
- put on a pair of pants. You may wear a robe if you would like.

After you get changed

- **Be sure to put your shoes back on if you took them off to get changed.**
- Put all of your belongings in a locker. Be sure to lock it and take the key with you.
- You will sit in the sub-waiting area until it is time for your treatment.

After Your Treatment

- You will go back to your changing room and change back into your clothes.
- Please place your used gown, pants or robe in the labeled linen chute. You will find these in the changing room or just outside the room.

Family and Friends

- If you have family or friends with you for your appointment, they will wait in the main waiting room. There is limited seating in the sub-waiting area.
- After you are changed, you may go to the main waiting area to sit with your family or friends until it is time for your treatment.
