Care After Prostate Ultrasound or Biopsy

This information will help you care for yourself when you get home.

Activity

- Do not lift anything heavy or exercise for 48 hours.
- Do not have sexual activity for 3 to 4 days.

Medicines

- Do not take aspirin for 1 week.
- It is OK to take acetaminophen (such as Tylenol[®]).
- Take all medicines as directed by your health care provider.
- Check with your health care provider before taking blood-thinning medicines (anticoagulants).

Food and Beverages

- Resume your normal diet.
- Drink 8 glasses of water a day.

Special Instructions

- You may see blood in your urine, stool or semen.
- Sit in a warm bath for discomfort or urinating problems.
