

# Atezolizumab (Tecentriq<sup>®</sup>)

Atezolizumab is an anti-cancer medicine that helps your immune system fight the cancer cells. This medicine is used to treat many types of cancer, including some lung cancers.

## How Is It Given?

- liquid by IV (intravenous)

## What Side Effects May Occur?

This is a partial list of the side effects you may have with this medicine. You may have some, all or none of those listed, or you may have other side effects not listed. Most side effects last only a short time.

### Common:

- constipation
- diarrhea (loose stools)
- nausea (upset stomach) and a decrease in appetite
- cough
- fatigue (feeling very tired)
- stomach pain
- urinary tract infection
- swelling
- headache
- trouble sleeping

### Less common:

- low thyroid levels
- back pain
- pneumonia
- reaction from how the medicine is given
- blood in your urine

## When To Call Your Doctor

Call your doctor if you have:

- allergic reaction:
  - itching
  - hives
  - swelling in your face and hands
  - tingling in your mouth or throat
- chest pain
- pounding heartbeat
- fainting
- feeling dizzy
- fast weight gain.
