

Venous Doppler Ultrasound

Before the Exam

- There are no special instructions.
- You will wear a hospital gown or you will be asked to remove your clothes from the waist down and cover up with a sheet.

During the Exam

- You will lie on your back on an exam table.
- Your arms will be at your side.
- Your head will be raised so you are not lying flat.
- The technologist will put a warm gel on your leg(s).
- He or she will move the ultrasound wand (transducer) down your leg(s).
- Pictures will be taken of the blood flow in your veins. The technologist can also listen to the blood flow.
- The technologist will gently press your leg(s). This is to increase blood flow in your veins.
- The exam takes about 20 to 40 minutes.
