

What to Expect During Your Appointment at the Outpatient Infusion Center

Infusion Center

The Infusion Center offers outpatient care for infusion therapy. This includes:

- chemotherapy
- central line cares
- blood transfusions
- shots (injections)
- iron therapy
- hydration
- blood draws from ports and lines
- phlebotomy from ports and lines
- IV antibiotics
- IV immune globulin
- infliximab (Remicade®) infusions.

Your primary care provider must do an assessment and write a referral for you to receive care at the Infusion Center.

Before Your Appointment

- Bring your insurance card and photo ID with you to your first appointment.
- Bring items to help you relax (book, cards or games, magazines, tablet or cell phone). You can also bring snacks or beverages, if you would like.
- You may be asked to arrive early to stop by the lab for a blood draw. The health care provider should have the results of these tests when he or she meets with you.

- If you do not need to stop at the lab, plan to arrive at the hospital 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment time.

During Your Appointment

- When you arrive at the hospital, go to patient registration. You will only need to register before your **first** appointment unless your contact or insurance information changes.
- You will be given instructions to wait in the waiting area until your appointment time. Coffee, tea or water will be available for you to enjoy.
- A staff member will bring you back to the room.
- You will meet with the health care provider. He or she will give you the treatment and talk with you about any concerns you have.

After Your Appointment

- The health care provider will give you instructions for scheduling your next appointment.

Guidelines

- Call the Infusion Center **at least 24 hours before your appointment** if you need to cancel or reschedule.
- If you are late for your appointment, you may be asked to reschedule.
 - More than three late cancellations or missed appointments within 3 months may limit your options for future appointments.
 - If you miss two weekend appointments, you will no longer be able to schedule a weekend appointment.
